### Increases in African-American Applications

- African-American applications have increased 30% since 2012, compared to a 19% increase for the class.
- African-American applications have increased by 567 students since 2013.
- African-American enrolling first year students have increased 44% during this time, compared to an 8% increase for the class.
- The number of first year African-American students, including multi-race, has increased 41% since 2012.
- This year African-American students represent 9.1% of the class, compared to 7.1% 5 years ago.
